## WHAT YOU CAN SAY<sup>1</sup>

As you talk regularly with your child, here are things you might say to them:

- “God made you. God loves you. Jesus wants to be your friend forever!”
- “Are you scared? Let’s talk to God about it.”  
(Pray with your child)
- “Isn’t that wonderful? Let’s thank God for it.”
- “Can you let your friend have a turn?”  
(Prompt them to share)
- “Can you help me carry these socks?”  
(Prompt them to help)
